

Course: Drama
Instructor: Ms. Crumrine & Mrs. Winter

Dates of note: All students will be required to attend and participate in plays on 11/12/16 and 2/25/17. Students in the class will also present another play during December for the elementary students.

Required Materials: iPad (charged) with required apps & eBooks.

Method of Instruction: The class will be conducted in a project-based learning workshop atmosphere. Students will engage in all aspects of a production, including directing, set design, costume design and acting. Students will also be responsible for teaching and participating in classroom workshops.

Method of Evaluation: Participation and performance will be self, peer and teacher evaluated.

Classroom Policies:

1. Respect yourself and others at all times.
2. Use class time wisely and turn in assignments on time.
3. Be responsible and trustworthy with time, location and equipment.

Consequences of violating classroom policies:

1. A first violation will result in a verbal warning.
2. A second violation will result in a conference after class.
3. A third violation will result in an after-school detention.
4. A fourth violation or a severe violation will result in a trip to the office.

Late Policy:

- Any schoolwork that is turned in late will be reduced by 20%. Whether it is a day late, a week late, or a month late, the maximum credit the student can earn on each late assignment is 80%.
- The student will be allowed to turn in schoolwork until the end of the nine weeks. After the nine weeks, no work from that nine weeks will be accepted and the student will receive a zero for any assignments that have not been turned in.
- All work missed due to an absence should be made up within one day (24 hours) after returning to school or class. After extended absences, students will be allowed one day (24 hours) per day of absence to turn in work without it being late.
 - Ex. If a student is absent for two days = that student will have two school days (48 hours) to complete work for full credit.

All policies detailed in the student handbook, including those for tardies, absences and academic honesty, will be followed.
